#### **Welcome & Introductions**

Coordinator Black opened the meeting at 10:03 AM and initiated self-introductions.

## Approval of the July 20<sup>th</sup> 2023 TAC Agenda and the May 18<sup>th</sup> 2023 TAC Meeting Minutes (Consent Calendar)

The TAC approved, with a motion and seconded.

#### 2024-2029 RTIP Development

Edward Coviello advised the TAC about the upcoming Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) deadline. Chair Gray asked about what projects a local member can include in the RTIP. Coordinator Coviello noted that projects that are planned or secured may be included at the members discretion. A question and discussion followed including discussing the recently awarded trail RAISE Grant award. Member Clark-Getzin provided guidance and the City of Sequim members provided feedback. Coordinator Black provided an overview of rolling the RTIP into the upcoming Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). This includes the Kitsap projects. Member Bateman asked if only regionally significant projects be included. Member Black described that other planned and secured projects could be included even if they are not regionally significant. The coordination platform of PRTPO is the value in adding the projects at the discretion of the jurisdiction. Member Mohr noted that Kitsap County may not want to add projects to the RTP project list using the PSRC RTIP. Coordinator Black responded that there is flexibility. More discussion followed about the idea. Coordinator Black acknowledged that more coordination should follow.

#### Regional Transportation Plan: Work Plan and Schedule

Coordinator Black reviewed the work plan. She reported about the Comprehensive Plan consistency requirement for the RTP. The TAC will help update a method for RTP consistency review with local Comprehensive Plans over the next couple of years. PRTPO's goal is to add value and not be a cumbersome process. Thera Black noted that the RCW was written in 1990 to help guide start up of growth management activities and was not designed as an ongoing process. However, the requirement remains. Member Bateman highlighted the value of coordination on projects. Ideas were brought up and to be discussed in the near future. The TAC accepted the idea. The RTP will be designed to be useful to members and the public alike.

Marty Allen asked about the important parts of the Work Plan and Coordinator Black suggested that the milestones are a good measure of the TAC involvement.

#### **Regional Transportation Plan: Public Participation Plan**

Coordinator Black asked for a recommendation of the Public Participation Plan for the RTP. There are two different elements using virtual tools. Public outreach will occur, and the Executive Board and TAC will have opportunities to shape the goals and policies. Then the interagency in reach will be completed to ensure synergy among the Regions members. The public will continue to be involved as the Plan develops, including a public hearing. The Human Services Transportation Plan will be used to reinforce the human side of transportation gaps, etc. The HSTP contacts will allow for outreach to our most vulnerable populations. The HSTP was adopted recently by the Executive Board recently.

A motion and second was made and the TAC unanimously approved the PPP for the RTP.

#### **Update on PRTPO Online Tools**

The beta GIS data platform was presented to the TAC by member Black which will support local planning data needs. It will also provide information to the public to help them understand the Region. Coordinator Black will send out a link to the TAC for their review and comment.

The beta version was shared via screen share to the TAC. The data is from the US Census and Office of Financial Management. There are some gaps in the data for the local cities and tribes.

A detailed presentation of the online mapping tools for use in presenting demographic data. Member Bateman asked about Limited English Proficiency Data. The PRTPO will work to include this data to assist jurisdictions in their Title VI reviews. Municipal level data will be available, but members should be careful with the boundaries of the Census tracts and block groups.

#### **Member Roundtable**

Chair Gray asked about member updates.

Member Boehme provided information on the Race Street Complete Streets project. The shared use path is installed, and the project is moving forward. Active work is being performed near Park. There have been road closures to get the water line in. The project paving should be done by mid-October.

Phase II is still in project development. Design funds are available. Construction funds are needed to complete the project to the Olympic Discovery Trail.

Member Clark-Getzin noted that the WSDOT fish passage project at Eagle Creek is in an outreach stage. There will be four days of road closures along US 101 from August 13<sup>th</sup> to August 18<sup>th</sup>.

Member Bateman announced the completion of the Johnson Road roundabout project on SR 305. He provided details of the project history, features, and functionality of the roundabout. He noted the partnership with Suquamish Tribe in developing the beautiful artwork on the project site.

Jonathan Boehme discussed the RAISE Grant for the Puget Sound to Pacific trail project. A kickoff meeting will be happening soon among participating organizations and FHWA. There will be a lot of effort to develop the scope of work and budget for this planning grant. They expect it will take anywhere from 9 months to two years to get all the work under contract in the Grant Agreement. There is a tremendous amount of coordination needed between all the partners to move this forward. Member Clark-Getzin asked about tribal participation in the process and whether those funds will be managed separately from the rest of the grant. It is not clear yet until the coordination meetings move forward. These are questions to be addressed with FHWA.

Subject: Recommendation on Transportation Alternatives Call for Projects

#### **REQUESTED ACTION:**

Recommend to the Executive Board whether to initiate a call for projects early in 2024.

#### **Background**

PRTPO is responsible for awarding federal Transportation Alternatives (TA) program funds to priority projects. Federal TA funds support a wide range of project types but are probably best known for funding non-motorized and *Complete Streets* projects, special landscaping and environmental remediation projects, Safe Routes to School projects, and historic preservation projects. All PRTPO members are eligible project applicants as are some other entities.

In 2020 PRTPO allocated four years' worth of funding in a single call for projects, awarding \$1.1 million to four projects. PRTPO planned to conduct a call for projects biennially from then on. During its call for projects in 2022 to award \$516,000, PRTPO received no funding applications. A debrief with TAC members revealed the dollar amount was too low to support a competitive federal funding process. It was determined at that time to consult with the TAC early in 2023 to determine the best window for a new call for projects.

In January the TAC advised waiting until the fall to revisit the question of whether to conduct a call for projects in 2024. This is that discussion, to determine whether to recommend to the Board that PRTPO launch a call for Transportation Alternatives projects in early 2024.

#### **Funding Availability**

The 2022 experience demonstrated that "programming ahead" four years creates a big enough funding pool to make the cost and effort of federalizing projects worthwhile. This process would program funds for fiscal years 2023-2026 plus a small amount of carryover funds. **This would result in \$1,389,000 in funding awards for TA projects.** PRTPO will strive to ensure that of that amount, at least \$503,700 goes to projects in rural areas and at least \$385,900 goes to projects in urban areas as defined by the 2020 Census.

#### **Next Steps**

It is assumed going into this that the same process used in 2022 would be the basis for a 2024 solicitation, refined as necessary to best meet current conditions. If the TAC recommends at its September meeting that the Board launch a call for projects in 2024, staff will bring details of the process back for discussion and approval in November. The TAC would submit any revisions to that process to the Board for its review and approval in December, and the solicitation would launch in January with awards in late spring.

Subject: Approval of 2024-2029 Regional Transportation Improvement Program

#### **REQUESTED ACTION:**

Approve the 2024-2029 Regional Transportation Improvement Program for the Peninsula Region.

#### Overview

One of PRTPO's annual responsibilities is to develop a six-year Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) in cooperation with WSDOT, local jurisdictions, and transit agencies.<sup>1</sup>

Certain projects in the first four years of the Regional TIP move automatically into the Statewide TIP (STIP) by virtue of their inclusion in the RTIP. Those projects include:

- a) Local agency or transit projects that have any federal funds AND are funding secured for that phase
- b) All WSDOT projects

Inclusion in the STIP is a prerequisite for agencies before they can obligate federally funded projects obtained through a grant or an earmark, and inclusion in the RTIP is a prerequisite for inclusion in the STIP. Obligation is the process of getting federal funds that have been awarded to a project committed to that project contractually for ten years and is a critical step in securing federally funded projects.

Other local projects in the first four years of the RTIP don't move automatically to the STIP. This includes any local projects showing only local or state funds, or those showing federal funds, but the projects are still planned and not yet secured. Inclusion in the RTIP for those projects anticipating federal funds is good because they can be amended into the required STIP more efficiently if they receive funds unexpectedly. It takes longer to add brand new projects to the STIP if they receive federal funds when they have not already been vetted through local, regional, and state TIP reviews.

The RTIP report is attached and includes over 150 projects from PRTPO members in three of the four counties. Kitsap County projects are included in the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) RTIP.

Upon the Board's approval the RTIP will be forwarded to WSDOT where it will be aggregated with those from other RTPOs across the state, and a STIP derived as described above.

#### INTRODUCTION

The Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) is a presentation of transportation projects proposed for implementation during a six-year period for the years 2024 through 2029. The PRTPO RTIP is made up of projects with federal funding, State of Washington funding and local funding from around the PRTPO Region. The RTIP describes the project, provides its projected costs, schedule for completion and associated funding sources. Importantly, The RTIP is consistent with the adopted Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) which can be located under the PRTPO Plan & Studies at: <a href="https://www.prtpo.org/documents">https://www.prtpo.org/documents</a>

The PRTPO Region is made up of a four-county area (Clallam, Kitsap, Jefferson and Mason Counties) and members include cities, counties, tribal nations, ports, and transit agencies. The projects listed in this document reflect members who choose to submit projects for review at the PRTPO Region. Kitsap County Members submit their RTIP projects to the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC). The RTIP is not a complete list of projects for each member jurisdiction.

#### DEVELOPMENT OF THE RTIP

The RTIP is an annual process that is brought to the PRTPO Executive Board for consideration in September of each year. The RTIP is required by RCW 47.80.023. Specifically, the RCW requires the RTPO to: "develop, in cooperation with the department of transportation, operators of public transportation services and local governments within the region, a six-year regional transportation improvement program which proposes regionally significant transportation projects and programs and transportation demand management measures. The regional transportation improvement program shall be based on the programs, projects, and transportation demand management measures of \*regional significance as identified by transit agencies, cities, and counties pursuant to RCW 35.58.2795, 35.77.010, and 36.81.121, respectively, and any recommended programs or projects identified by the agency council on coordinated transportation, as provided in chapter 47.06B RCW, that advance special needs coordinated transportation as defined in RCW 47.06B.012. The program shall include a priority list of projects and programs, project segments and programs, transportation demand management measures, and a specific financial plan that demonstrates how the transportation improvement program can be funded. The program shall be updated at least every two years for the ensuing six-year period."

\*Regionally significant project means a transportation project (other than projects that may be grouped in the TIP and/or STIP or exempt projects as defined in EPA's transportation conformity regulations (40 CFR part 93, subpart A)) that is on a facility that serves regional transportation needs (such as access to and from the area outside the region; major activity centers in the region; major planned developments such as new retail malls, sports complexes, or employment centers; or transportation terminals) and would normally be included in the modeling of the metropolitan area's transportation network. At a minimum, this includes all principal arterial highways and all fixed guideway transit facilities that offer an alternative to regional highway travel.

The RTIP is presented to the WSDOT after Executive Board approval for inclusion in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP). Only projects with secure funding are included in the STIP. Projects with planned funds are left in the RTIP until they are ready to move from planned to secure. In the project descriptions a letter "P" is found on the left side of the funding description for planned funding while an "S" is for secure funding.

Once funds are secured, the RTPO forwards the projects to WSDOT for inclusion into the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The STIP has a public review period similar to the RTIP. A summary table is provided on page 4 detailing the funding totals by categories of federal, state and local funds by jurisdiction.

#### **POLICY FOR AMENDMENTS**

New projects or those requiring amendment beyond the WSDOT administrative thresholds are brought before the Executive Committee for discussion and forwarding to the Executive Board agenda. Projects needing an expedited approval process are brought before the Executive Board without Executive Committee review for consideration no later than 14 calendar days before the next scheduled Executive Board meeting. Projects submitted less than calendar 14 days prior to the Executive Board meeting will be forwarded to the next scheduled Executive Committee meeting for consideration.

PRTPO coordinators track projects by the date of Executive Board approval.

Existing projects may continue to be amended using WSDOT amendment guidelines.

PRTPO coordinators will update the RTIP once the Executive Board has approved the project.

Subject: RTP: Project List Approach

#### **REQUESTED ACTION:**

No action is requested. This is the first of a couple of discussions about the RTP project list and the role of the Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) in shaping that list.

#### Overview'

Since its inception in 1995, the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) has addressed projects on the regional transportation system in different ways.

- In 1995 the first RTP included a prioritized list of projects describing regional mobility and capacity needs which
  local agencies and WSDOT were expected to include in their plans as they were developed and updated. It left
  safety, preservation, and maintenance priorities to the individual members to identify, though recognizing them
  as important regional needs. The RTP directed what projects local and state agencies should pursue. That first
  RTP envisioned the project list would be updated annually though no updates were conducted for almost 20 years.
- In 2015, when that original RTP was finally updated, PRTPO declined to include specific project recommendations. Instead, the RTP described transportation system needs and strategies, but left identification of the specific projects and prioritization to local, tribal, and state agencies to incorporate as appropriate into their own processes. It recognized the important work of member agencies in defining and developing projects as funding allows and the regionally coordinated structure of the RTIP as the best representation of those project priorities, with the RTP providing an over-arching coordinating framework.
- In 2019 the most recent RTP update incorporated the 2019-2024 RTIP directly as its project list. It described the funding secured projects as regional "funded priorities" and listed the planned projects as well. Only six members had planned projects included on that list, not as a result of PRTPO limiting the list but due to variations in how different agencies participate in the RTIP process.

The approach proposed for this update is to adapt those earlier processes and standardize future annual updates. It would lean heavily on the Regional Transportation Improvement Program derived from locally adopted TIPs as the best indicator of near-term funding priorities and incorporate RTIP projects into the Regional Transportation Plan formally when PRTPO adopts its new RTIP every year. As currently envisioned, the RTP project list in the future would include secured and planned projects submitted to RTIPs and importantly, that list would be updated annually.

There are advantages to this approach and some challenges. This is the first focused discussion by the TAC on this process and the questions that need to be answered over the next year before it can be implemented in 2024.

#### **Considerations for the RTP Update**

Determination as to what specific projects to pursue and when are decisions best made by local, state, and tribal partners, not PRTPO. Adopted TIPs that go into the RTIP reflect real-world factors like funding availability and project delivery coordination needs that must be made by implementing agencies who own and operate the transportation system.

Projects in adopted six-year TIPs are based on financial, operational, and system analyses that no RTPO can reasonably generate. Additionally, the six-year list of projects each agency adopts typically reflects more than six years of funding need and/or availability as agencies work to pre-position their many investment needs for the various funding processes and cycles it takes to obtain project funding. That is why the RTIP – secured and planned projects approved annually by cities, counties, tribes, transit, WSDOT, and even ports if they have projects – is potentially such a good reference point for project priorities over the next decade or so.

Inclusion of unfunded projects in the RTIP and in the RTP can be beneficial to those members working to obtain project funding. Projects included in the adopted RTIP and in the RTP can give a boost to applications in competitive funding processes. And because the RTIP is updated annually, the projects it includes can be amended annually into the RTP, ensuring that its project list reflects the most current project funding needs of its members.

At the same time, there are challenges to using the RTIP as the RTP project list.

For starters, conflicting state laws regarding the TIP, the RTIP, and the STIP mean that local agencies outside of Kitsap County are not required to include their projects in the RTIP in order for them to go into the STIP. This results in different agencies approaching the RTIP differently in terms of what to include or whether to even submit anything at all. This is likely part of the reason why only six agencies had any projects listed as unfunded needs in the 2019 RTP update, which did incorporate the 2019-2024 project list. In the proposed approach, agencies would continue to voluntarily submit projects to the RTIP; PRTPO cannot force participation by cities, counties, or tribes. Those from Clallam, Jefferson, or Mason Counties who choose not to submit projects into PRTPO's RTIP would not have any projects identified in the RTP. This would be something for local agencies to consider before putting together their local TIPs next year and determining what, if anything, to send forward to the RTIP.

There is also an issue in that projects from PRTPO's Kitsap County partners go into the PSRC Regional TIP, not PRTPO's. There is no ambiguity in state or federal law for those members; they must submit their projects to PSRC for inclusion in that RTIP or else their projects cannot go into the STIP. This means they are not included in PRTPO's RTIP when it is adopted. To make this RTP/RTIP project list work, projects from PRTPO's Kitsap partners would need to be inserted into the proposed project list for inclusion in the annual RTP project list update. We would need to work out the logistics for that to ensure it entails minimal additional effort on the part of PRTPO members.

Finally, some may feel that only "big projects" of a certain size or only projects located on the regional transportation system should be included in the RTP. As proposed, the RTP list would include all RTIP projects from members, recognizing the important role of seemingly small local, tribal, and state projects in making the whole transportation system work for all users. This is a question to explore further with the TAC.

There are likely to be other practical considerations that have to be addressed before we can know if the RTP update will include project recommendations derived from the RTIP. This discussion is a chance to vet this idea and identify any issues that will have to be reconciled.

#### **Next Steps**

Staff will begin following up on outstanding issues and questions raised by the TAC and bring this back for future discussion. As currently envisioned, adoption of the RTIP in 2024 would launch development of the first RTP project list under this approach, for inclusion in the update that will be adopted in June 2025.

**Subject:** RTP: Preliminary Assessment of Core Requirements

#### **Requested Action:**

No action is requested but feedback on the approach to meeting minimum requirements is greatly appreciated. TAC input will inform the next stages of the update.

#### Background`

At this stage of the update, I am assessing how much time we need to spend rehashing some of the foundational elements that are required to be in PRTPO's transportation plan, before we get into other things PRTPO might want the plan to be and do beyond those minimum requirements. The current plan, adopted in 2019, is compliant with those state requirements. Reusing or repackaging those elements of the 2019 RTP that are still current will free up time for PRTPO to examine other areas of interest in this process. TAC input is key to this assessment.

#### Requirements

The long-range RTP that PRTPO must develop and maintain includes some core foundational elements specified in state law. Rules governing what PRTPO must consider in its long-range plan are codified in the <u>Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 47.80.030</u> while <u>Chapter 468-86 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC)</u> provides guidance and outlines planning principles RTPOs should consider.

The rules governing what PRTPO must include in its RTP to comply with state law have changed very little from when they were put into place in the early 1990s to guide the earliest Growth Management start-up activities around coordinated transportation-land use planning in Washington. Some may even be confusing if the RCW or WAC are read outside of that historic context. It is useful to remember how revolutionary GMA was in 1990, which was reflected in RTP requirements.

RTP requirements for rural regions like PRTPO boil down to a few key thingss that are now hard-wired into PRTPO's plan as well as local, state, and tribal plans across the region.<sup>1</sup> To comply with RCW 47.80, PRTPO's RTP must:

- Define what is understood to be the regional multimodal transportation system that should function as an integrated whole.
- Establish level of service (LOS) standards for state highways and state ferry routes except for those designated as Highways of Statewide Significance. [WSDOT establishes LOS for those routes.]
- Include a financial plan demonstrating resources are reasonably available to carry out proposed improvements.
- Promote development patterns that support efficient and cost-effective operations and preservation.
- Promote the preservation and efficient use of the existing transportation system to maximize mobility of people and goods.
- Propose a regional investment program to guide development of the transportation system.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> There are many similarities between what RTPOs must include in their RTPs under state law and what MPOs must include in theirs under federal law, but there are also critical differences. PRTPO does not have the same federal and state statutory authorities as PSRC which is why this update is concerned with state compliance only. If there are questions between the two, please let me know.

- Develop goals, objectives, and information that supports consistent, on-going coordination among local, state, tribal, and other stakeholders in their efforts to identify and advance near- and long-terms strategies that improve the region's transportation system.
- Monitor performance of the regional transportation system over time, at a minimum to include traffic volumes and vehicle miles of travel (VMT).

There is also a well-meaning requirement for least cost planning that is widely recognized now as impractical beyond promoting sound asset management practices.

#### Preliminary Review

I reviewed and compared the original 1995 RTP, the 2015 RTP update, and the 2019 RTP update to look at how each addressed these basic requirements. As a relative newcomer to PRTPO's regional planning process, I needed to better understand how those plans evolved over time as PRTPO's regional planning program matured alongside local comprehensive planning processes. That would give me a sense of how well those elements meet current needs in addition to meeting those statutory requirements.

If the core assumptions that have guided PRTPO for almost 30 years and satisfied state requirements are still relevant, then this update can focus on future uncertainties and strategies for PRTPO in this post-transition era as an independent organization. If the underlying assumptions and policies on which earlier plans were based are no longer relevant or current, then this update will need to revisit and rectify the core GMA coordination requirements before we move on to other considerations. PRTPO's first priority is to ensure its updated RTP meets those basic state requirements.

Based on my assessment, I think we can simply carry forward most of the required elements from the current plan in a refreshed format. My findings are summarized below, for TAC discussion and direction.

#### Core assumptions to vet with TAC:

#### a. Define the regional transportation system: Clarification and minor updates warranted

The regional transportation system is understood to be the more significant facilities and services that support mobility and access over a wide area. It reflects a somewhat finer level of detail than facilities of statewide significance but not as finely detailed as the local system. Where state and local systems intersect are often facilities of interest.

PRTPO has adopted plans over the years that describe the regional transportation system in the language of the RCW. It is evident in the goals and policies that the regional system includes more than state highways but that could be spelled out a little clearer and simpler with this update. Following is a summary of what I believe is PRTPO's definition of the *regional transportation system* based on prior plans, for verification by the TAC:

- i. State highways (Highways of Statewide Significance and Highways of Regional Significance)
- ii. Ferry routes and terminals (including WSF, Kitsap Transit, Black Ball) (Note: WSF also = HSS)
- iii. Local arterials [Question: Major collectors too?]
- iv. Any other local facilities designated as T2 freight facilities
- v. Transit routes, programs, services, transit centers, Park-and-Ride facilities (public transit, tribes, Greyhound)
- vi. Human services transportation programs for people with special needs (incl non-profit and NEMT services)
- vii. Olympic Discovery Trail and Sound-to-Olympics Trail [Question: PS2P as planning / concept project?]
- viii. Marine terminals
- ix. Airports
- x. Navy railroad

Based on PRTPO discussions since 2019, this update might expand that definition of Regionally Significant Facilities to include:

- xi. Broadband infrastructure (Agree?)
- xii. EV infrastructure and facilities (Agree?)

Policy language makes explicitly clear in various ways that highways, streets, and roads should accommodate all modes of travel to the extent safely practical.

Clarification of what is meant by the **regional transportation system** will be used to develop an inventory of regional facilities and services with online data tools to support basic information and communication needs over time.

#### b. Establish Level of Service standards: no change needed

PRTPO adopted a LOS standard for state facilities of LOS D for urban areas and LOS C for rural areas. That standard has been in place for almost 30 years and is incorporated into locally adopted Comprehensive Plans and WSDOT's own State Highway System Plan. It applies only to Highways of Regional Significance. LOS for Highways of Statewide Significance is established by WSDOT. The two LOS standards are identical. There is no indication that any change is needed or desired.

#### c. Include a financial plan: refresh based on project list approach

Though listed as its own requirement, this is closely tied to (e), below. If PRTPO uses projects from the adopted RTIP for the RTP project list, as proposed, the financial plan would mirror the approach to the RTIP financial plan. That is, it would be based on committed revenues associated with secured projects. Planned projects are illustrative of need until funded. Note that this RTP update does not anticipate developing a theoretical long-range revenue forecast or a detailed analysis of how agencies have spent transportation revenues over time. If there are concerns about this, let's talk about them.

## d. Promote development patterns that support efficient and cost-effective operations and preservation: no change needed

In its original plan PRTPO laid out a regional transportation strategy that aligned with the tenets of the Growth Management Act: concentrate growth in urban areas where transit, biking, and walking are viable options for more trips; promote measures to reduce single-occupancy vehicle trips; state and local investments in preservation and safety are regional priorities. This guidance was carried over into local comprehensive plans and in 2015 was embedded into PRTPO's RTP vision statement. It is now integral to local and regional plans. No change is warranted.

# e. Propose a regional investment program: modest update warranted, based on proposed RTIP-project approach Earlier on this agenda TAC members will discuss the potential role of the RTIP in generating a project list for the RTP. As proposed, this list would be updated annually in conjunction with the RTIP review and approval process. While some questions and logistics need to be worked out, this appears to be a viable strategy that not only satisfies RTP requirements but could also better support members in their efforts to secure funding for planned projects by including them on the "RTP project list." This approach would also seem to institute what might have originally been envisioned for the RTP project list. That more in-depth discussion will inform this review.

## f. Develop goals, objectives, and information to support coordinated planning: <u>either</u> minimal change is needed, or major change is needed

Each successive RTP has had more goals, policies, principles, and data points than the previous, with updated buzzwords to go with the successive state or federal bills driving policy and funding. The 2015 plan offered a big expansion and language updates from the original 1995 plan adopted twenty years earlier. The 2019 update made more modest expansion and changes to the 2015 language. A big decision to consider now is how much time to allot

towards refining the current goals and policies section for this update. That depends in large measure on how members actually use this section of the RTP.

PRTPO's goals and policies speak to practically any aspect of multimodal transportation or coordination that may be of interest in this rural region. They provide useful citations or references for grants or planning processes. The 2019 RTP update has 21 system goals supported by 130 policies. It also has 120 strategies for the state system grouped by the six statewide transportation policy goals. You can quickly link to these from the table of contents in the 2019 RTP.

Based on my review this seems to be a fairly static element that adequately meets PRTPO's compliance needs. It offers a compendium of goals and policies that demonstrate clear linkage to all the core GMA planning considerations a rural RTP is meant to support. A very simple update to reflect current considerations and terminology from recent state legislation (Climate Commitment Act, HEAL Act) may be all that is needed for the existing policy section to meet any need someone would turn to it for. Key is keeping that refresh simple. Revisiting and fine-tuning all of those goals, policies, and strategies to make them a little bit better would consume a large amount of the TAC's very limited time and resources available for this update while likely generating minimal value in return.

To understand the best approach to this it would be helpful to know if and how members use the RTP goals and policies. I'm particularly interested in whether anyone has ever referenced them for purposes other than citations for grant applications. *TAC members, have you ever referred to the RTP goals and policies in the last five years? How well do they work for your purposes? Can we get by with a simple refresh or is more effort warranted?* 

#### g. Monitor system performance: no change needed

PRTPO is required at a minimum to monitor changes over time in VMT and traffic volumes on state facilities as a part of the information it includes in its RTP. This update will compile a VMT record for the state system and link users to real time traffic count data. We are working with the WSDOT Transportation Data Office and its online resources to assemble this information into a historic record of performance over time that can be easily updated in the future. Absent more robust planning capacities and resources, though, it would be unwise to propose additional metrics beyond what is required unless readily available data exists, and the resulting product satisfies an information gap for members.

This is my preliminary assessment of the transferability of these elements from 2019 into the new update. In general, it seems as if little time will be needed to rehash those earlier components of the plan; mostly, they just need to be repackaged into the new online format. The more efficient we are in meeting those minimum requirements, the more time and capacity we have to engage in other aspects of planning for this RTP that are of interest to members. That is why this TAC discussion is such important input now, as it will determine how we tackle these requirements and the next stages of work in this update.

#### **Next Steps**

TAC insights will inform the Board discussion in October about its vision and strategic approach to this update. Depending on the TAC discussion we will come back in November to build on the intent and strategic direction laid out by the Board in October or we will begin reviewing the items above in detail and start editing them as needed for this update.
